IMPORTANT: Do not order certificates through the ESP online store until your analyzer has received the second phase of the upgrade. Online purchases will only work if you are communicating over the internet using software version 1.37 or higher.

NEW PROGRAM ORIENTATION

Station and technician orientation material is now available online. Printed versions of this material will be sent out with your 2012 station and mechanic permits after your renewal fees have been paid.

ESP EQUIPMENT UPGRADE

We have authorized ESP to begin performing phase two of the upgrade. The main focus of this software version (v1.37) is the proper functionality between the analyzer and the new VID (Vehicle Information Database). There will be another software release in either the first or second quarter of 2012. The main focus for the next software version will be to improve the end user experience and "fine tune" the system. Written comments or suggestions from our stations are always welcome.

VIR REPRINT

The menu item "Reprint VIR - County Computer Query" will allow any station to reprint any VIR that was generated using the new software. This feature will only work for inspections performed using the new software, and only within the past 90 days. The VIR reprint function will only print the most recent passing inspection, not any failing, aborted or not ready VIR's. Stations may charge up to \$3.00 for a VIR reprint regardless of where the test was conducted.

TECH TIP # VE0057 Editing a VIN, or other data entry field

Here's a neat trick for editing any of the data fields in the analyzer. For example: The VIN entry can be a tedious manual entry with many chances to make a mistake. If you realize you've made a mistake you don't have to use the backspace key and delete all of the correct data while trying to reach the error. Instead, hold down the Ctrl key and use the arrow keys to move the curser to the area that needs editing. You may now overwrite the character you want to change. If you want to insert a character that was missed, hit the insert key on the keyboard, then press the character key you wish to insert.
