Online Renewals Available

Each station should have received an annual renewal invoice. We now offer an online renewal option, and we encourage you to take advantage of this convenient process. If you prefer not to renew online, please contact our office to ensure we have up-to-date email addresses for your station, station owner, and technicians. As part of our transition to online procedures, we expect that next year, all renewals will be handled exclusively online.

Technician Renewal and Practical

Technicians who want to stay in the program starting January 1, 2025, must pay for their license renewal

and pass a practical exam. Payments are due by January 1, 2025, or they will be locked out of the emissions analyzer. Due to staffing shortages, many technicians haven't had the chance to complete the practical exam at their shop. Therefore, we are extending the deadline for the **practical exam** until April 1, 2025. During this time, auditors will focus on practical exams. If a technician is offered the chance to complete the practical at their shop but refuses, they must schedule an appointment at the Tech Center. Technicians who do not wish to renew their license do not need to complete the practical exam.__

2025 Emission Control Application Guide Available

The 2025 Emission Control Application Guide is now available. If you will be due for an updated manual next year you can order the 2025 now. Remember, you must have a guide that is no more than **three years old.** If your newest guide is 2022 you will need a newer one in January. If you go past the grace period, March 31, 2025 you will be locked out **until you have the required guide**. You can order 2025 now and have smooth sailing for the next three years.
