

Upcoming Contract Transition

Our current Vehicle Emissions Program contract will expire on December 31, 2025. We have been working diligently to finalize a new contract beginning January 1, 2026.

This new contract will introduce updating testing equipment and revised regulations to improve program efficiency, accuracy and compliance across all I/M stations, modernizing our program for years to come and keeping pace with emerging automotive emissions technology and offering greater convenience for the public.

New Program Implementation and Equipment Installation

Implementation of the new program will begin soon. All current certified I/M stations will receive priority installation of the new testing equipment to ensure full operation before the current contract expires.

We will provide additional details about the installation schedule, equipment transition process and support resources in the coming weeks. Our goal is to make this transition as smooth as possible for the stations, technicians, and the public.

Required Training for all Technicians

All current certified technicians will be required to complete training for the new program.

Training will include:

- Equipment Training — Presented by *Opus*, covering use and maintenance of the new testing equipment
- Regulation Training — Presented by *Utah County Air Quality*, covering updates to procedures and program requirements

Sessions will be held after business hours (**6:00-8:00 PM**) at the Utah County Emergency Management Building, located near the Tech Center on our campus at **364 W 3200 N, Spanish Fork**.

Training Dates:

11/3, 11/5, 11/10, 11/12, 11/13, 11/17, 11/18, 11/19, 11/24, 11/25

(The two final sessions will only be held if earlier classes reach capacity)

Each technician is required to attend one of these classes. Attendance is mandatory for all technicians who wish to remain active in the Utah County Vehicle Emissions Program. **Technicians who do not attend one of the available classes will forfeit their certification and will be required to recertify to continue to participate in the Utah County Vehicle Emissions Program.**

The training cost is \$10 per technician.

Parking will be available at the Emergency Management Building, and at the Jail Industries Building, with overflow parking at the Tech Center. Do not park in front of bay doors or any CONEX containers. Please only park in lined parking stalls. See attached map for details.
